All dancers are required to have proper Irish dance footwear. Shorts, and t-shirt should be worn to class. Hair should be pulled back away from the face. Please bring a bottle of water to class. Jeans, sweat pants and long skirts are not recommended.

➤ **Parents/Guardians**

If parents/guardians (and siblings) wish to stay at the hall, they are required to use the back room until class is finished.

➤ **Costumes/School Dress**

We have a **beginner uniform** and a **school dress**. Beginner uniforms can be worn for approximately 2 years afterwards, students are encouraged to acquire a school dress.
